State Controller Releases State Transit Assistance Allocation Totals

The California State Controller's Office has posted the regional allocation totals for the \$400 million statewide State Transit Assistance Program (STA) allocation to be distributed this month.

The "gas tax swap" budget package signed in late March by Governor Schwarzenegger made an immediate \$400 million appropriation to transit operations from the existing Public Transportation Account (PTA) balance. The payment is a one-time lump sum amount which will cover the remainder of 2009-10 and 2010-11. Please note that the total amount allocated is \$399,984,000. This is because the State Controller's Office normally receives a small percentage of the allocation for administrative costs.
