## **RULES AND INFORMATION**

**FORMAT:** 4-Person Scramble - Each group must select a captain who is responsible for scoring. Record the team's gross (actual) score for each hole on the official scorecard. Return the official scorecard, signed and attested, to the scoreboard located in the courtyard immediately upon completion of play.

**TEES:** Men - White tee markers Women - Red tee markers

### **SCRAMBLE RULES**

- 1) **Tee shot requirements:** Two (2) tee shots are required by each team member.
- 2) All players tee off from their respective teeing area. After the best shot has been selected, the other team members will pick up their golf balls and proceed to the location of the best shot where they each will play their next shot. (Each of the players may place his/her ball within a club length of the best shot, but no nearer the hole.) This procedure is continued until the ball is holed out. At the end of each hole, the score for the group is recorded on the scorecard. There is only one score per hole.
- 3) If a selected shot is played from a hazard, bunker, rough or fringe of the green, again the ball must be placed within a club length of the shot selected, no nearer the hole, and must remain in the hazard, bunker, rough or the fringe or the green. On the putting green, the original putt must be marked with a coin or another small object and each player attempting a putt may position the ball no more than two (2) inches from the mark.
- 4) When putting, once the ball is holed out, no further putts may be taken. The team is cautioned not to make tap-in putts until all members have had the opportunity to attempt the team's original putt.
- 5) **Missing Player Procedure:** If a team is short a player, the remaining players in rotation may play a second ball so that four (4) shots are taken from each selected position until the ball is holed.
- 6) Ties will be decided by matching scorecards of the teams tied on holes #10-#18. If a tie remains, then the total of holes #13 - #18 will be compared. If a tie still remains, the total of holes #16 - #18 will be compared.
- 7) No extra holes shall be played. Result: disqualification!

### **SPECIALTY HOLE CONTESTS:**

- **Closest to the Pin #7 and #17** - Any player whose tee shot comes to rest on the green is eligible for this contest. Use the tape measure attached to the flag pin to measure the distance of your ball from the hole. Record your name and measurement (i.e., 1'2", etc.) on the proximity marker provided.
- **Longest Drive #12** - Any player whose tee shot comes to rest beyond the proximity marker (ball must remain in the fairway) is eligible for this contest. Record your name on the proximity marker and place it as near to the position of where your ball lies prior to hitting your second shot.

**(Continued)**

**MULLIGANS:** One mulligan (free replayed shot) per person will be distributed at registration. Mulligans may be used anywhere on the golf course except to win a hole-in-one or specialty hole contest.

**LOCAL RULES:**

**USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by the following local rules:**

**EMBEDDED BALL:** Through the green, a ball embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground, other than sand, may be lifted without penalty and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole.

**FLOWER BEDS: MANDATORY RELIEF.** All flowerbeds on the course are ground under repair. If a ball lies in or touches the flowerbed, or when such condition interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, relief must be taken as prescribed under Rule 25-1.

**IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Yardage rocks are immovable obstructions. #18-Windmill and its surrounding hedge is an immovable obstruction. If an immovable obstruction interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the producer prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

**LATERAL WATER HAZARDS:** Identified by red stakes and defined by red painted lines.

**WATER HAZARDS:** Identified by yellow stakes and defined by yellow painted lines.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by white stakes. #9-course side edge of the cart path located directly behind the driving range and course side edge of cart path curbing behind green is OB; #11-left of fairway is OB; #12-left of the cart path is OB; #13-left of fairway and behind green is OB.

**PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES: MANDATORY RELIEF.** Identified by stakes, support wires or ropes. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the producer prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i).
